

Credit for Prior Learning

Students from high schools that participate in the Seal of Biliteracy program are eligible to earn test credit for meeting the required levels of language proficiency through assessment. Credit for these assessments will be awarded as follows:

North Dakota

- Spanish Gold Seal - 12 Credits for SPAN 101, 102, and 201
- Spanish Silver Seal - 8 Credits for SPAN 101, 102
- Other Language Gold Seal - 12 Credits of Language Elective
- Other Language Silver Seal - 8 Credits of Language Elective

Minnesota

- Spanish Platinum Seal - 12 Credits for SPAN 101, 102, and 201
- Spanish Gold Seal - 8 Credits of Language Electives
- Other Language Gold Seal - 12 Credits of Language Elective
- Other Language Silver Seal - 8 Credits of Language Elective

*Seals of Biliteracy attained outside of North Dakota and Minnesota will be assessed independently through the Office of Registration and Records.

How to Submit Your State Seal of Biliteracy

Biliteracy seals are recorded on the high school transcript. Students should complete the **online request form** once a final high school transcript has been submitted to the NDSU Office of Admission.
