The Master of Engineering degree requires a minimum of 30 semester credits beyond the B.S. degree. The Master of Engineering is a course-work only program requiring a capstone consisting of a portfolio or written exam.

Admission and Application Requirements

- Graduate School admission and application requirements are found on the Admission Information (<http://catalog.ndsu.edu/graduate/admission-information/>) page.
- In addition, this program requires applicants to have a GRE score of at least 145 Verbal and 155 Quantitative and a minimum GPA of 3.0 on your Electrical Engineering or Computer Engineering B.S. degree.
 - The 3.0 minimum GPA admission requirement may be waived for applicants with substantial ECE industry experience.
 - The GRE subject area test is not required.
