

Graduate Courses

3.1. Graduate Courses

Courses approved at the 600, 700 and 800 level may be taken for graduate credit and used to satisfy course requirements on the student's graduate plan of study.

- Didactic courses are those courses approved for graduate credit numbered 601-689, 691; 700-789,791; 800-889, 891.
- Courses numbered 690, 692-699, 790, 792-799, 890, 892-899 are special or experimental courses. These credits may be used on a Plan of Study as non-didactic credits.
- Audited courses and Distance and Continuing Education courses are not eligible to be used to fulfill degree requirements
