## Agribusiness (Corporate Track) Minor

The Agribusiness minor with a corporate track is an alternate track to the Agribusiness minor in the Department of Agribusiness and Applied Economics (<http://bulletin.ndsu.edu/past-bulletin-archive/2014-15/undergraduate/colleges/agriculture-food-systems-natural-resources/agribusiness-applied-economics>) . The minor supplements a student's technical training in agricultural sciences with an understanding of fundamental business concepts and applies business strategies to corporate agribusiness decision-making. The Agribusiness minor with a corporate track is restricted to students with a major in the College of Agriculture, Food Systems, and Natural Resources (<http://bulletin.ndsu.edu/past-bulletin-archive/2014-15/undergraduate/colleges/agriculture-food-systems-natural-resources>) , excluding agricultural economics and agribusiness majors.
