State Board of Higher Education

Created by constitutional amendment in 1939, the State Board of Higher Education (https://ndus.edu/sbhe-overview/) is the governing body of North Dakota State University and all other state supported institutions of higher education in North Dakota. The nine-member State Board of Higher Education is the policy-setting body for the North Dakota University System and consists of seven citizen members who serve four-year terms and who are appointed by the governor, one student who is also appointed by the governor for a one-year term, and one faculty member who is selected by the Council of College Faculties. The board's chief executive officer is the chancellor of the North Dakota University System, with offices in the state capitol in Bismarck.
