Master of Science

Completion of a Master of Science degree is dependent on the completion of 30 semester hours in Plant Pathology or approved courses from related departments. A minimum of 10 credits must reflect research in the desired area.

Doctor of Philosophy

Completion of a Doctor of Philosophy degree is dependent on the completion of 60 semester hours beyond the M.S. degree or 90 credits postbaccalaureate. Courses may include Plant Pathology or approved courses from related departments. A minimum of 10 credits must reflect research in the desired area.
